



CALLING ALL ALFRED NZO GARMENT MANUFACTURES

Alfred Nzo Development Agency (ANDA), Alfred Nzo District Municipality (ANDM) and the Fibre Processing and Manufacturing SETA (FP&M SETA) forged a partnership to stimulate socio-economic development within the District. Garment manufacturing has been identified as one of the strategic industrial sectors to catalyse industry development in the area for fashion designer graduates and sewing groups involved in garment manufacturing activities. It is this pool of local talent that the partnership wishes to organise through the provision of garment manufacturing infrastructure, technical training and Business Management Training interventions to improve both the design and quality of garment products manufactured in the District.

It is against this background that these organisations afford Alfred Nzo District Garment Manufactures an opportunity to gain available skills in the Fashion Design industry that will enhance their competitiveness and improve the quality of garments manufactured and business management.

Therefore, ANDA in partnership with ANDM and the FP&M Seta are looking for 50 applicants seeking admission for the implementation of the Resident Fashion Designer training programme. Applications are open to candidates from throughout the District. The training programme will be implemented at Mbizana Cultural Village and Emfundisweni Skills Development Centre.

Applicants are requested to submit the documents listed below for screening and selection purposes:

In order to be eligible for Training:

- The applicant must be in position of Fashion/ sewing available business,
- Designer qualification from a recognised and accredited institution; or Grade 12 / Grade 9 report accompanied with an affidavit stating that the designer is self-taught
- Applicant must be from the Alfred Nzo District (Ntabankulu, Matatiele, Umzimvubu and Mbizana) – proof of residence (letter from ward councillor/utility bill) must be attached
- People living with disabilities are eligible to apply.
- Be full time committed to the programme, utilizing all resources, similar to a full-time job. (Submit signed commitment letter.
- Provide a minimum of two (2) images of your garments. Ideally work that best reflects the product focus.
- Submit Completed Application form, Curriculum Vitae and certified copies of certificates, Report and I.D
