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Section 1: Introduction

The Agency is in a process of revitalising the site in order to draw investment and further create jobs. The Agency is also responding to a need to develop sectors that create sustainable jobs and provide opportunities to SMMEs particularly women and youth. Mbizana Chicken Abattoir is located along R61 at Winnie Madikizela Mandela Local Municipality. The Agency intends to appoint a service provider supply, deliver and erect fencing at the Abattoir.

Section 2: Objectives of the Project

2.1 Overall objective

To attract investment to the region, give opportunities to the SMMEs to participate in the economic activity through the spin offs that will be provided through the abattoir where the intended outcome is to promote entrepreneurship, reduce high levels of unemployment and stimulate District economic growth and development.

2.2 Specific Objectives

The specific objective of the project is to supply, deliver, erect fencing and installation of galvanized gate at Mbizana Chicken Abattoir.

Section 3: Scope & Extent of Work

Bids are invited from suitably qualified professional service providers to prepare and submit proposals to supply, deliver, erect fencing and installation of galvanized gate at Mbizana Chicken Abattoir.

The following are the key activities that need to be undertaken by the appointed service provider:

- Supply, deliver, erect galvanised fencing and installation of galvanised gate for the designated area or site.
- Ensuring compliance with norms and standards
- Adhere with compliance on Occupational Health and Safety
- Handing over of site to the client upon completion of the project
- To quantify and verify size of the land in the identified areas using any relevant tool or device that will deliver accurate size of the space to be fenced and identification of pegs and coordinates (Perimeters , Kilometres and Hectares)

- To construct the required infrastructure as per specification. The work shall be approved by ANDA staff, prior to erection
- It will be the responsibility of the appointed service provider to undertake full time site supervision and quality assurance of all work undertaken by the appointed contractors.
- Refurbishment of the existing security guard house

Section 4: Duration

The project time frame will be 2 (two) months from the date of appointment of the service provider.

Section 5: Key Deliverables

The key project output is the Supply, deliver and erect galvanised fencing, installation of galvanised gate and refurbishment of guard house for security at Mbizana Chicken Abattoir within the jurisdiction of Winnie Madikizela Mandela Local Municipality. The duly appointed service provider therefore will have onus to supply and deliver the stock fencing material which is South African Bureau Standards approved.

Section 6: Appointed Service Provider

The successful bidder shall design and erect the required infrastructure as per specification. Designs shall be approved by ANDA staff, prior to erection. These designs shall remain an intellectual property of ANDA.

Section 7: Project Management

As per project management perspective, should the appointed service provider fail to deliver on any activity, the commissioned service provider will be penalized and according the terms and conditions stipulated in the Service Legal Agreement to be signed by both parties (ANDA and the appointed service provider).

The project is to be coordinated and managed by Alfred Nzo Development Agency Team. The service provider have to submit an invoice accompanied by the progress report of work claimed to be conducted, verification will be done prior to the processing of payment.

Section 8: Reporting Mechanisms

It is expected that regular progress reports will be submitted to Alfred Nzo Development Agency. The Project Manager has the right to change the frequency of reporting as and when necessary.

Section 9: Selection and Evaluation Criteria

ANDA subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles whereby a bidder's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the award of points in respect of the tender value and Specific Goals.

Price and Preference goal 3 will be used for evaluation. The 80/20 preferential point system will be applicable, with 80 points for price and 20 points for Specific Goals.

Prequalification: Only bids of bidders adhering to the minimum CIDB grading designation, and whose CIDB registration is active will be considered further.

The bid will be evaluated in two stages, namely:

- **Stage 1- Capacity to Execute Work**
- **Stage 2 - Price and Preference Goal system (Goal 3)**

- Copies of Director's ID Documents must be certified with a certification that is not older than 3 months.
- Joint Venture agreement should be in JV agreement format
- All prospective service providers of goods and services and infrastructure procurement are to be registered on Central Database in order to do business with all organs of state in the Republic of South Africa(**Attach CSD Report**).
- All bidders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 1SQ or higher(Attach CIDB registration certificate)
