Section 1: Introduction

These terms of reference outline ANDA's intention to recruit suitable service provider for refurbishment of 1x sheep shearing shed located in ward 3 at Ephifane village under Matatiele Local Municipality. The Agency intends to appoint a service provider to construct and revitalise the sheep shearing shed, build one (1) toilet and fence the site. The successful service provider shall perform the required services in line with high quality standards and shall follow all the scope of work as well as deliverables indicated in this TOR

Section 2: Objectives of the Project

2.1 Overall objective

The specific objective of the project is to undertake site clearance, revitalize and construction of one sheep shearing shed, building of a toilet and fencing of the site.

Section 3: Scope & Extent of Work

Bids are invited from suitably qualified professional service providers to prepare and submit proposals to revitalize, deliver and construct one shearing Shed at the below indicated areas:

The following are the key activities that need to be undertaken by the appointed service provider:

- Conduct a site clearing (cut the trees and remove the stumps as well as all obstacles from the ground such as stones, remove damaged infrastructure such as buildings within the site).
- Revitalising of buildings and deforestation.
- Demolishing of one side wall and rebuilding
- Supply, deliver, and erect galvanised fencing and installation of galvanised gate for the designated area.
- Construct 1 standard toilet including necessary with steel windows and wooden door
- To quantify and verify size of the land in the identified areas using any relevant tool or device that will
 deliver accurate size of the space to be fenced and identification of pegs and coordinates (Perimeters,
 Kilometres and Hectares)

- To refurbish the required infrastructure as per specification. Work shall be approved by ANDA staff, prior to construction
- It will be the responsibility of the appointed service provider to undertake full time site supervision and quality assurance of all work undertake by the appointed contractors.
- The appointed service provider will also have responsibility for ensuring compliance with building norms and standards
- The appointed service provider must ensure compliance with Occupational Health and Safety
- Service provider will be responsible for the handing over of site to the client upon completion.
- The risk of loss by theft, fire, storm, riots or any other risk related to materials therein shall rest entirely
 with the bidder immediately after the handover of the site. The bidder must take steps as may be deem
 necessary or fit for the protection against the stated risks.

Section 4: Duration

The project time frame will be 5 (five) months from the date of appointment of the service provider.

Section 5: Key Deliverables

The key project output is the Supply, Delivery and Refurbish of Sheep Shearing Shed, building 1 toilet and Fencing at Matatiele Local Municipality at Ephifane Village in Ward 22. The duly appointed service provider therefore will have onus to supply and deliver the stock fencing material which is South African Bureau Standards approved

The duly appointed service provider therefore will have onus to supply and deliver the stock fencing material which is South African Bureau Standards approved. Furthermore, a service provider is required to compile and submit progress reports on the following:

- Site clearing,
- Deforestation and revitalization of buildings
- Building of 1 standard toilet
- The erection of fencing and gate installation

Section 6: Appointed Service Provider

The successful bidder should refurbish the required infrastructure as per specification. Work shall be approved by ANDA staff, prior to construction.

Section 7: Project Management

As per project management perspective, should the appointed service provider fail to deliver on any activity, the commissioned service provider will be penalized and according the terms and conditions stipulated in the Service Legal Agreement to be signed by both parties (ANDA and the appointed service provider).

The project is to be coordinated and managed by Alfred Nzo Development Agency Team and Project Steering Committee (PSC). The service provider have to submit an invoice accompanied by the progress report of work claimed to be conducted prior, verification will be done prior to the processing of payment.

Section 8: Reporting Mechanisms

It is expected that regular progress reports will be submitted to ANDA and further presented to the PSC on a monthly basis. The Project Manager has the right to change the frequency of reporting as and when necessary.

Section 9: Selection and Evaluation Criteria

ANDA subscribes to the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles whereby a bidder's submission will be evaluated according to the sum of the award of points in respect of the tender value and Specific Goals.

Price and Preference goal 3 will be used for evaluation. The 80/20 preferential point system will be applicable, with 80 points for price and 20 points for Specific Goals.

Prequalification: Only bids of bidders adhering to the minimum CIDB grading designation, and whose CIDB registration is active will be considered.

The bid will be evaluated in two stages, namely:

- Stage 1- Capacity to Execute Work
- Stage 2 Price and Preference Goal system (Goal 3)

Proposal will be evaluated in terms of the SCM Policy of Alfred Nzo Development Agency and shall be applied as follows: -

- Submit company registration certificate and a valid SARS pin number confirmation certificate

- Municipal clearance certificate certifying that no municipal rates and service charges are owed by the bidder

- Copies of Director's ID Documents must be certified with a certification that is not older than 3 months.
- Joint Venture agreement should be in JV agreement format

- All bidders must have a minimum CIDB contractor grading designation of 1SQ and 1GB or higher

- The bidder must own or lease TLB and Tipper truck (Proof of ownership or lease be attached)
